FUND DESCRIPTION

The Vetiva Banking ETF "VETBANK ETF" is an open-ended Exchange Traded Fund managed by Vetiva Fund Managers Limited. The VETBANK ETF is designed to track the performance of the constituent companies of the NGX BANKING Index and to replicate the price and yield performance of the Index.

INDEX DESCRIPTION

The NGX BANKING Index comprises of the top 10 banks listed on the Nigerian Exchange Group ("NGX") in terms of market capitalization and liquidity and is a price index weighted by adjusted market capitalization.

MARKET REVIEW & OUTLOOK

The Nigerian equities market turned bearish in June as investors engaged in profit-taking following the strong gains recorded in previous months. Consequently, the NGX All-Share Index (ASI) declined by 8.37% month-on-month to close at 229,419.18 points, reflecting weaker investor sentiments across the equities market.

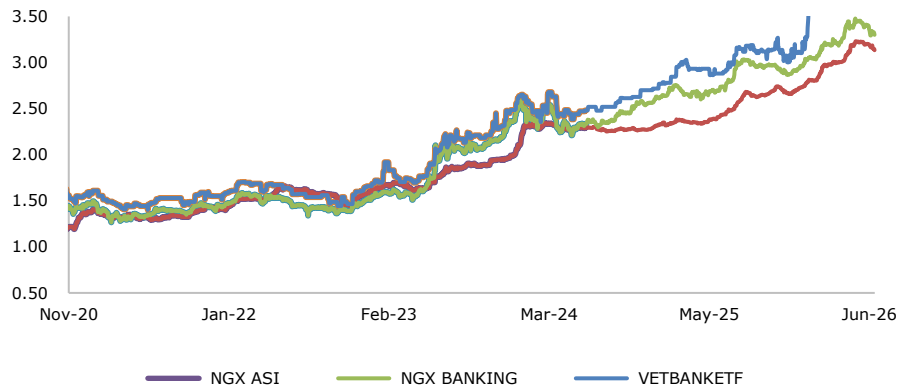
The NGX Banking Index mirrored the broader market's performance, declining 12.22% m/m as profit-taking pressures weighed on all constituent stocks. The sector's performance was led lower by the likes of FIRSTHOLDCO (-19.93%), ZENITH (-16.09%), GTCO (-8.76%), just to mention a few. Despite the broad-based correction in June, the Banking Index delivered an 11.25% q/q return, supported by sustained investor interest during Q2 following the completion of recapitalization exercises and the release of the Central Bank of Nigeria's draft guidelines for Financial Holding Companies (HoldCos).

Looking ahead, we expect strong corporate earnings to help restore positive market sentiment and support further market gains in the banking sector. We expect fundamentally strong Tier-1 banks with resilient earnings and consistent dividend-paying histories to remain well positioned to outperform.

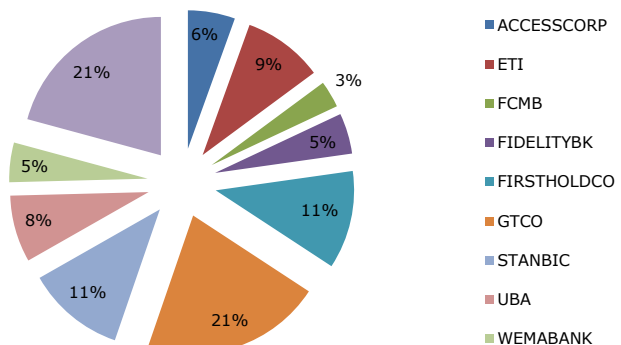
